Levy gave a brief explanation regarding the trash fees for 2020. They must consider an increase in rates.


Bailey stated she had concerns with the sidewalks and the fact snow removal is not being done by all residents. She wanted to know if they are being issued citations.

MEETING TO ADJOURN


Councilmember Ellsworth moved to adjourn and Councilmember Bailey seconded. All Aye. The regular meeting adjourned at 8:13 PM.
