

# What can be Recycled?

\* Important \* Put all items loose in the carts. Do not use plastic bags.

(Using plastic bags will cause extra work and might result in your recycling being put into the trash instead of recycled.)

## Paper Products:

- clean cardboard (detach and throw away greasy sections)
- newspaper & inserts
- cereal & food boxes
- tissue boxes
- beverage carriers
- NO shredded paper, tissue, or paper towels



## Metal Products:

- aluminum cans
- food & tin cans (RINSED)
- empty aerosol cans



## Styrofoam Products:

- coffee & beverage cups
- package inserts (no peanuts please)
- clam-shells (RINSED WELL - remove all greasy parts)



## Plastic Products:

- #1 through #7 plastics (marked on the bottom, usually)
- rigid plastic toys
- RINSED milk jugs & beverage bottles
- detergent containers
- waste and laundry baskets
- RINSED milk & juice cartons



## Glass Products:

- RINSED food jars
- RINSED beverage bottles
